This event has taken place for three years and has garnered tremendous support and positive feedback from students, Alumni and the Administration. In an effort to continue this meaningful relationship and to get more Alumni involved, SCSAA is in the early planning phase of creating the Alumni Sharing Knowledge (ASK) Network.

The Association will invite all alumni to opt-in to the program by being part of a searchable online database including your name, class year, sports and/or extra-curricular involvement, post-high school education or military service, internships, professional experience, current occupation and personal interests/hobbies.

This information will be hosted on two kiosk-style, touch screen monitors located in high-traffic areas in the Sidney High School. Students will have the ability to search this database to locate information relevant to their needs. They can then choose to contact you in a manner in which you prefer (i.e. by email, messenger, phone, etc.) to ask questions relative to your experience. This can give students a direct perspective on their field of interest and the knowledge and excitement that they too can pursue a career path after leaving Sidney schools and become successful.

SCSAA will also use this database to recruit Alumni to participate in events like Career Day and other programming that would benefit from having a work and world perspective. The Association will not give nor make accessible your information to an outside party and will share the information only as you allow. Our goal is to give students a perspective from individuals who have no doubt been in their shoes before but have found their way to business and career success.

The Association will also host historical information including: profiles of Sidney Wall of Fame Inductees, Sports Hall of Fame Inductees, notices of Alumni

We look forward to your involvement and willingness to give back to the community, school and alumni which helped shape us all during some of the most important developmental and influential years of our lives.

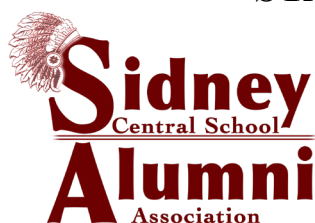
